## **RE: TUCKSHOP AND LEARNER BATHROOMS**

### **Tuckshop**

Our tuckshop, as we formally knew it, has been forced to close for the time being, due to social distancing being difficult to manage. However, toasted sandwich and sausage roll orders are taken upon entry to the school, for those learners that wish to order. Our tuckshop ladies follow strict cleaning and food handling procedures and we assure you that the prepared food items are 100% safe for your children to eat. The tuckshop ladies are also screened before they enter the school property and begin food preparation. Children may order a toasted cheese and ham sandwich, a plain toasted cheese sandwich or a beef sausage roll at R15-00 each. These orders may be placed on a daily basis.

Since the tuckshop is closed, Snack Lucky Packets can be purchased from Monday, 22 June 2020. These will vary, but will have an assortment of tuckshop items at a cost of R15-00 each. These orders must also be placed upon entry at the gate.


### **Learner Bathrooms**

It has come to our attention that some learners feel apprehensive to make use of the bathroom facilities at the school. We would like to assure both learners and parents that the learner bathrooms are strictly monitored, cleaned regularly and that all necessary hygiene equipment is available for the learners.

outside each bathroom






Each toilet cubicle has a sanitiser spray for before and after use, as well as pedal bins.

Every venue in the school has a cleaning roster displayed. Bathrooms are cleaned and sanitised three times a day.



There is liquid soap for the learners to utilise. Additional disinfectant spray is available to spray taps before use.



The hand towels have been removed and replaced with paper towel dispensers. A large pedal bin has been placed in all bathrooms.



During break times, each class has an allocated play area, with their own peg bucket. The pegs are submersed in sanitiser. When a learner requires to use the bathroom, the teacher on duty allows him/her to take a peg and peg it onto their collar. The teacher on bathroom duty will not allow a learner into the bathrooms without a peg (meaning that no learners wander around the school without permission). Only three children are allowed in the bathroom at any given time and a teacher is posted at the bathrooms for supervision and strict control.

We trust that this information will disseminate any concerns that learners or parents have regarding the use of the learner bathroom facilities.
